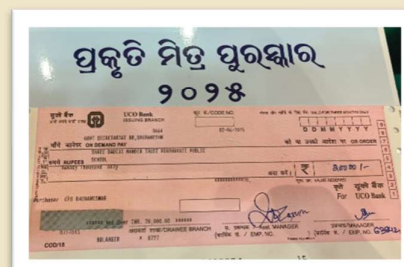

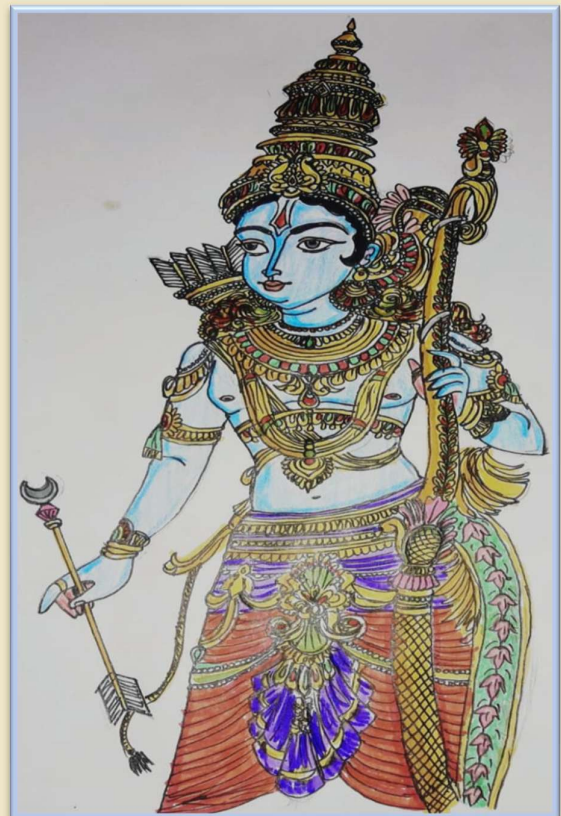
## THE POWER OF CURIOSITY
